

Extract of the News from the Dental Council of India

IGNOU-Dental Council of India (MOU)

The IGNOU, Indira Gandhi National Open University, has recently also tied up for the first time with the Dental Council of India, through which it will offer PG certificate programmes to students in selected dental colleges of the country. As against 267 dental colleges in the country, Madhya Pradesh has 11 dental colleges, wherein four dental colleges each are being run in Indore and Bhopal respectively.

As per the MoU signed with the DCI, the IGNOU will open two centers in Indore one at Modern Dental college and the other at Government Dental college to start PG certificate courses in Endodontics and oral implantology respectively. Tiwari said that the an MOU in this regard with the DCI will help students to get higher degrees in dental science which was not possible earlier because of scarcity of PG courses in the dental colleges.
