

Extract of Notifications from the Medical Council of India

NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRANCE-TEST-PG

NEET-PG:

- The common entrance test (CET) for admission to Medical Post-graduate Courses across the country i.e. National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test for Medical Postgraduate Courses - MD/MS/Diploma (NEET-PG) shall be held in Jan-Feb 2012 for admissions in the academic year 2012-2013. The syllabus is that of MBBS described in the MCI Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997. The multiple choice questions (MCQs) would be based on the MBBS syllabus as well as the knowledge that needs to be acquired during internship which is also described in the said Regulations. The distribution of questions, model questions and method of tie breaking for ranking would be placed on the website in the due course.

NOTICE from MCI WITH REGARD TO COMMUNICATION THROUGH OFFICIAL LANGUAGES

This is to inform that the Medical Council of India is receiving communications in different languages from the States all over India.
